




Programs of Study

FIVEFOLD MINISTRY TRAINING

The Fivefold Ministry Training Program of Study Training Program of Study is a two-track program that will give students an opportunity to earn a certificate of completion and/or become potential candidates for ordination through Global Change Network (GCN). The program courses have been carefully selected and planned to provide effective training for those called to positions of ministry leadership.

CVTS General Information

Withdrawals and Refunds

You may officially withdraw from an individual course or Program of Study at any time. However, you are only eligible for a tuition refund during the first two weeks of the school term. If you wish to withdraw from an individual course or Program of Study, you must request a refund within the first two weeks of the semester. Tuition refunds will not be granted following the second week of the semester. An automatic refund of tuition will be processed in the event of a course cancellation.

Attendance Policy

Regular attendance is required of all students in order to successfully complete each course. General attendance requirements, based upon the course length, are listed below:

- · For 6 to 7 week courses, students may not be absent more than one (1) time.
- · For 8 to 11 week courses, students may not be absent more than two (2) times.
- · For 12 to 13 week courses, students may not be absent more than three (3) times.

Please Note: Students in the GCN Fivefold Ministry Ordination Program must complete all workshops outlined in the Program of Study schedule prior to being ordained. Any other attendance requirements will be provided by the course instructor.

Class Cancellation Policy

CVTS may cancel a class meeting for the following reasons:

Faculty Absence: If a faculty member is unable to attend a scheduled class, and a substitute is not available, class will be cancelled. Every effort will be made to contact students about a class cancellation. Text and email messages will be the primary means of alerting students.

Inclement Weather: If it becomes necessary to cancel a class due to inclement weather, every effort will be made to notify students and faculty as soon as possible. Notification may be made by text message and/or e-mail. As a student, you are encouraged to call the CVTS Hotline (303-368-7108) to inquire about a class cancellation due to inclement weather. You also are encouraged to check the website (www.cvtsonline.org) for class cancellation information.

Low Enrollment: CVTS may cancel an entire course due to low enrollment. If enrollment for a particular course is too low, the CVTS administration may cancel the course. In such cases, you will be notified by U.S. mail, phone, or e-mail. As a student, you also will receive the applicable refund of tuition and fees paid.


The Book of Revelation Bible Study (BS-201)


Becoming a Son of Covenant (DS-260)




Husbands & Fathers (DS-261)


Spiritual Warfare




Fasting, Spiritual Language, and Praying effectively Workshop (DS-375WS)


Consider Yourself (DS-376)



Cornerstone Marriage (Formerly Marriage 101) (FAM-225)




Loving Your Husband (FAM-227)
